CO-REQUISITES: None

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will experience a full time job placement in the community. The goals are to practice the skills and behaviors learned in the academic year and establish a full time position. The placement will last a minimum of 4 weeks.

COURSE DELIVERY:

The course content may be presented through a blend of instructional methods, including lecture, Internet, discussion, independent study, audio/video conferencing and videotape.

RATIONALE:

A full time job will provide the students with a realistic experience in the work place. Students will continue to explore career opportunities and develop personally while practicing work ethics and skills that are necessary for success in the workplace.

Upon successful completion of the course the student will be able to:

1. demonstrate skill specific to their placement
2. demonstrate accountability for their actions
3. behave with appropriate standards
4. interact with others to promote effective working relationships

5. maintain a log of prescribed format summarizing their placement experiences
